## IMDM ON BOARD AT SANCTUARY COVE INTERNATIONAL BOAT SHOW

International Marina Development & Management (IMDM) will be show casing its services and two of its premier properties at the annual Sanctuary Cove International Boat Show, May 21-24.

IMDM currently owns the Hope Harbour Marina at Hope Island and the Breakwater Marina in Townsville, with several other acquisitions in the pipeline across the country.

Hope Harbour is one of the Gold Coast's most popular marinas with the fantastic Broadwater just a few minutes from its entrance and has undergone a transformation in regards to services and pricing in recent months.

Hope Harbour is now one of the most user-friendly and affordable marinas in South-East Queensland and offers berths from 25 to 100 feet, according to Marina Manager, Mike Davis.

"When IMDM purchased Hope Harbour Marina we looked at how we could improve the services and make them more realistic for our customers and guests," said Davis.

"We have managed to do both and we are looking forward to talking with hundreds of potential Hope Harbour Marina customers at the Boat Show.

Hope Harbour is one of the few permanent marinas in the area that offers a fully-stocked general store and management assistance when re-fuelling.

Monthly berthing fees start at as little as \$500 with 12-month rates starting at \$4,200.

As part of a Sanctuary Cove International Boat Show special offer, any one booking a six or 12-month berth will be provided with a one and two month bonus respectively.

Breakwater Marina is currently at full occupancy, but offers short-term berthing as plans are put in place for a total rejuvenation of the Townsville marine precinct.

"IMDM is only a young company, but we believe we are setting a new standard in marine development and management," said Davis.

Online general admission prices are \$A22 for adults and \$A19 concession. This year, free entry for children has been extended to those aged 14 years and under. A Two Day pass will be available for \$A40. The online pre-purchased tickets offer a small discount over the event day entry prices of \$A23 adult and \$A20 concession. Conditions apply.

There is a range of activities during the Show, which opens 9am to 5pm daily. This includes Club Marine cooking demonstrations with celebrity chef Bart Beek; displays by Channel 7's Creek to Coast program with host

Scott Hillier and presenter Dean Miller on site to answer fishing and boating questions. Sally Jenyns is on site daily for cooking demonstrations. On Friday, Saturday and Sunday see Classic Hits 4KQ's outside broadcasts while street entertainment is scheduled daily. Radio station 92.5 Gold FM is broadcasting on the weekend from 10am to 1pm.

There is no on site public parking at the Show. Visitors can instead choose park 'n' ride, water transport by water taxi or ferry, limousine or taxi drop off or helicopter drop off.
